Treasurer Nancy Casteel reported:

- * ending balance of \$4,331.81 as of March 2014
- * 2013 e-card (990-N) was submitted and accepted at the IRS website on March 15, 2014

- * our Electrology Rule changes have been approved by the Medical Board (The changes have to be approved in legislation and then by the governor.)
- *The committee will administer the electrology exam on June 23, 2014 to 3 students (Sara DuBois, Natasha Mars, and Julie Bushong)
- * Peggy Dohlman asked that the Committee eliminate 3 items from the required curriculum since those items are no longer available for purchase or

even find. They are 1) Dr. Schuster video on electric tweezers; 2) Kay Lasker book on electro epilation; and 3) Clinical Assessment of Body Hair Growth in Women by David Ferriman and J.D. Gallway.

- * Peggy asked the Committee to verify that a Committee member can also be a preceptor
- * Peggy requested copies of the amended Electrology Rules that are going before legislators
- * Peggy asked that we allow not just "actively practicing" electrologists to be on the Advisory Committee, but to also allow retirees

2014 - time for <u>election of officers</u>. Peggy moved that the current three officers stay in office, Tracie 2nd and the motion passed.
